



A SIMPLE S.O.A.P. TIP TO DOING DAILY DEVOTIONS.






Read the Bible verse, passage or devotion story.

How do you feel when you know there is a camera on you?


How about when you know God is watching over you and knows everything about you, even what you are thinking?
